

Schooner Island Marina August 10th, 2007

To our Valued Winter Service & Storage Customers,

We would like to thank everyone for a great summer at Schooner Island Marina. Many people have been asking about winter storage so we wanted to get our contracts out early to secure your spot at Schooner Island. As always we have very limited land space available for dry storage and we can only accommodate you on a 1st come 1st serve basis.

Storing here this winter is the first step to secure your spot as a Schooner Island Marina "VIP Member." The other two steps are to be slip and service customers. If you store, slip, & service here you will receive a 5% discount on all marina purchases, including fuel. You will be getting more information on the program this winter.

Schooner Island Service Department will be performing all raw water winterizations at the time of haul out. If you have any questions about this procedure we will be more than happy to help you. This will be included in the winter storage rate. We would also like to remind storage customers that all work below the water line must be performed by Schooner Island Marina service personnel. This includes **bottom & out drive painting, replacing zincs, power washing, soda blasting, removing & reinstalling props, and replacing cutlass bearings.** We have added two new things to the storage contract for this year. First, disconnecting batteries will be separate. We will be happy to do this for you if indicated on the winter storage contract. Second, all boats stored here should have the fuel treated. This consists of adding stabilizer to the fuel tanks. Either we will do this for you or you should do it yourself.

We do offer in-water winter storage. Boats must be over 30 foot with inboard engines and fiberglass. All in water storage boats must be fully winterized by the customer unless arrangements have been made with the Schooner Island Marina Service Department. After we install the ice eaters in the slip the boat may not be moved from the slip. No one is permitted to stay on their boat during the winter at Schooner Island Marina.

The winter storage contract is attached, please check off all services required and the date you would like to be hauled out and stored. We also require an estimated launch date for next year so boats will be accessible for launch next year in the proper order.
